GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK PERFORMED:

Perform biological and chemical analyses for environmental health within the water and wastewater industry. This includes collecting samples by using clean sampling protocol and wet chemistry technique for examination of BOD, TKN, Total Organic carbon, Total Trihalomethanes, mono-chloramines, chlorides, solids, nitrate, nitrite, and microbiological analytes. Analyses meet NPDES and EPA requirements and are based on "Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater" procedures. Tests determine regulated permit compliance and process quality control. Periodic special test sampling and analyzing may be required. Carrying out routine tasks accurately and following strict methodologies for preparing media, reagents and operating laboratory equipment, for example centrifuges, titrators, pipetting, ISE meters, spectrophotometer, distillation and digestion equipment. Ensuring the laboratory is well-stocked and resourced. Using computer and software to input data and generate reports, laboratory forms, etc. Maintains laboratory work areas in clean and orderly appearance, meeting EPA and department of Environmental Quality inspection requirements.

DESIRABLE EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

A two-year degree or relevant course work from a vocational/technical training center or college, or subsequent laboratory work experience is highly desirable.
