

JCUA RECEIVES PERFECT SCORE FROM THE MISSISSIPPI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Mississippi State Department of Health regularly inspects drinking water supply systems. After a January 12, 2016 inspection of the Jackson County Utility Authority East and West Water Supply System the JCUA received a technical managerial and financial score of 5 on a scale of 5.

This is a continuation of a perfect record for the JCUA's Public Water System since it was tasked by the Mississippi Legislature in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina to build a public water system in its service area in Jackson County.

The 5.0 continued rating is a tribute to the dedicated and hard working staff and employees of the JCUA's public water enterprise. The JCUA continues to expand its water and retail systems in the service area assigned by Mississippi, who will make all efforts to maintain safe and reliable drinking water supplies for the citizens of Jackson County.
