All proposals for Professional Services must will be evaluated by the Jackson County Utility Authority (JCUA) using the following for general guidance:

Any proposal must demonstrate the ability to satisfy the development and execution of Professional Services requirements described in the GUIDANCE FOR WATER POLLUTION CONTROL REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROJECTS FUNDED BEGINNING FY 2016 (OCTOBER 1, 2015 AND LATER) as prepared by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality, or successor documents. Several reference documents are attached here. However, all interested parties are encouraged to review the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality web page for Water Pollution Control (Clean Water) Revolving Loan Fund (WPCRLF) Program Guidance to become familiar with the latest requirements.

Additionally, proposals must demonstrate technical capacity and experience in providing professional services for renewable energy projects, specifically solar photovoltaic conversion, that includes technical analysis of existing operations and cash flow analysis for projects expenses and operational outcome as the Cost Effectiveness section of the Facility Plan will be critical in final project considerations.
