### **BOIL WATER ALERT LIFTED**

Effective date: **Wednesday, January 24, 2024 at 3:40 P.M.**

Jackson County Utility Authority – **JCUA West Water System (MS0300164 - Jackson County)**

Customers Affected: The Jackson County Utility Authority – **West Water System (MS0300164)** residents located in the Pinehurst, St. Andrews, and South Pointe Areas of Jackson County.

As of 3:40 P.M. Wednesday, January 24, 2024, JCUA has received **adequate bacteriological sample test results in accordance to MS Dept. of Health requirements and JCUA has lifted its precautionary boil water alert** for its West Water System (MS0300164, Jackson County) for residents located in the Pinehurst, St. Andrews, and South Pointe Areas of Jackson County.

**Public Water System: JCUA West Water System (MS0300164 - Jackson County)** lifted the precautionary “Boil-Water Alert” for customers who get their drinking water from their water system in **Jackson County**.

Tests performed indicates the water is now safe to drink.

#### **When your Boil-Water Alert is lifted**

**Flush faucets** for a total of ten (10) minutes to introduce system water throughout house plumbing.

*Example:*

- 1 Faucet — Run for 10 minutes
- 2 Faucets — Run both for 5 minutes
- 3 Faucets — Run each for 3-4 minutes

Flush any faucet **a minimum of two (2) minutes** to ensure clearing of the line serving the faucet.

- **Discard any drinks**, ice, food, etc., made during the Boil-Water Alert.
- **Rewash** any food or drink contact items (knives, forks, plates, etc.) with "cleared" system water.
- **Check water filters** (in faucets, refrigerators and elsewhere) and replace if necessary.
- **Run dishwasher** through a cycle or two before washing dishes.
