Please Attach to Application. ****NOTE** This Will be the Same Legal Description Provided to MSDH. The Parcel ID Number can be Acquired by Contacting the Jackson County GIS Department at (228) 769-3458 or Land Records at (228) 769-3131.**
- 4. <u>MUST</u> Provide a Utility Service / Will Serve Letter or MSDH Approved Soil & Site Evaluation.
- 5. <u>MUST</u> Provide a Completed Appendix E Form or Appendix D (as applicable) Signed by Property Owner. (Provided By JCUA)
- 6. All Fees will be rendered at the time Certification is picked-up. All fees must be paid in full before Certification / Will Serve is released. (*Payable By Cash, Check, Or Card*) Fees are subject to change upon services rendered for completion of certification letter.

To ensure the Certification Process is completed in a timely manner, please ensure that all necessary documents, dates, and signatures are attached at the time the application is submitted.

Applications without all necessary documents, dates, and signatures will be considered incomplete and the process of certification will not begin until all necessary items are submitted.
